Our National Flag

Our national flag has three colours in it. We call it 'Tiranga'. It has stripes of three colours. Saffron Colour is at the top, white colour in the middle and green colour is at the bottom. These three colours of our flag have important messages. The Saffron stands for 'Sacrifice'. The White stands for 'Peace'. The Green stands for 'Prosperity'. Our National flag has a blue Wheel called Chakra in the middle of the white portion. There are 24

spokes in the Chakra. This symbol of Chakra has been taken from the Ashoka Pillar at Sarnath.
